

Unique Unicorn



1. Divide the white modelling clay into 3 (1/3 per person). Create 1 larger ball and 5 equal sized balls.



2. Use 3 smaller balls to create the 'body', a single ball for the legs. **Keep** a ball for mixing the colours.



3. Using half of **one** white ball, use a **tiny** pinch of black to create grey. Using a small amount of grey create the hooves.



4. Shape two small triangles to form the ears. Using the remaining white clay, use a **tiny** pinch of red to create pink.



5. Use a small amount of pink to create the inner ears.



6. The mouth is formed from an oval of grey. Use the tools to form nostrils.



7. Using thin cones of red and pink, produce your Unicorn's horn.



8. Using a tool, press holes for the horn and eyes. Gently place these into position.



9. Use the coloured clay to create long thin strands of 'hair'.



10. Using strands of clay, form your Unicorn's mane.



11. Using the remaining strands, twist your Unicorn's tail.



12. Carefully use a skewer to push holes through the head and body beads.



13. Place in the oven at 100-120°C for 20 mins to harden. Do not exceed a hardening temperature of 130°C or harmful gases may be produced.



14. Slip a 30-40cm length of cotton onto your key ring and form a 'cow hitch' knot.



15. Once cool, thread your unique unicorn onto the waxed cotton and keep in place using a knot (or three).
